RECOMMENDED CLIMBING ROUTES BETWEEN ROSENGARTEN AND LATEMAR

Rosengarten group

Climbing route Santnerpaß

Point of departure: Rosengarten hut, 2339 m, beautiful ascent to the heart of the Rose Garden, surrounded by steep walls and towers with magnificent views.

After ca. 2 ½ to 3 hours you reach the Santner hut, 2734 m. way back on the way there, or on steep road N 542 over the Gartl hut to the Vajolet hut, than further on way N. 541 and N. 550 over the "Tschagerjoch" back to the Rosengarten hut.

Marking N. 542s

Requirement: good endurance is necessary.

Climbing route Rotwand

Point of departure: Paolina hut, 2125 m. Exemplary secured climbing route over the north ridge to the „Rotwandspitze“ (top of the Rotwand), the main peak of the southern Rosengarten group, 2806 m.

Variety: Descent to the Rotwand hut (backed steep road) or below of the "Fensterleturms", sequel of the via ferrate Masarè and way back to the Paolina hut.

Marking N. 539 and N. 551

Requirement: easy – medium

Climbing route Masarè

Point of departure: Rotwand hut, 2280 m. This rock way is attached to the south climbing route Rotwand and leads from the Rotwand hut to the Punta Masarè, 2585 m. Descent from here to the Rotwand hut.

Requirement: medium to difficult.

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Climbing route Kesselkogel

Point of departure: Grasleitenpaß hut, 2599 m. The Kesselkogel, 3004 m, is the highest elevation in the Rosengarten group and is regarded as one of the best viewpoints of the Dolomites. The top of the Kesselkogel can be achieved in the west climb or in the east climb.

Requirement: medium.

Climbing route Laurenzi

Point of departure: Tierser Alpl hut or Antermoia hut, 2441 m. The via ferrate Laurenzi, the only climbing route over the Malignonkamm, leads through a high alpine area between Tierser Alpl and Antermoja. North site, the steep crashes down to the green Duron Valley and the broad expanse of the Seiser Alm. South site, the enormous scenery of Kesselkogel - Rosengarten, the Pala group, up to the queen of the Dolomites, the Marmolada, 3343 m.

Requirement: particularly difficult.

Over the Scalette way to the Passo Lausa (2720m)

Point of departure: Refuge Gardeccia, 1950 m. The Scalette way is also called Larsec way. Larsec is the name of unknowns, eastern the Rosengarten group stocked mountain chain. The way leads from the Gardeccia hut trough the Larsec group to the Antermoja hut, 2497 m.

Requirement: easy.

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Latemar

Climbing route „Campanili del Latemar“,

Point of departure: Obereggen, 1550 m. Ascent to the top of the Latemar, descent to the Schorte (Bivak Rigatti). Begin of the climbing route on the south site of the Latemars from east to west.

Marking N. 9 and N. 18, Climbing route N. 511.

Requirement: medium, endurance is necessary (up to 8 hours).

Schlern massif

„Großer Roßzahn“

Point of departure: Tierser-Alpl hut, 2441 m

After the narrow canyon between the great- and the eastern „Roszahn“ you reach on rock steps, for first a wind gap (beautiful view over the Seiseralm) and left follows then the summit ridge to the highest point, 2630 m.

Marking: red-white

Requirement: easy.

Maximilian steep road to the Roterdspitze and transgression of the Roßzähne

Point of departure: Tierser Alpl hut; The varied climbing route begins after the transition of the Schlern plateau on the western back of the Roterdspitze and finished with the transgression of the Roszähne, 2653 m.

Requirement: easy.
